

BOOK CONDITION GUIDE

SUPERIOR CONDITION

Heritage Classic Collectables considers 'SUPERIOR' condition to be when books are in <u>'as new'</u> condition. There will be no signs of wear and tear and no hand-writing on the blank pages (Leaves) at the beginning of the book, such as names of previous owners, etc.

GOOD CONDITION

Heritage Classic Collectables considers 'GOOD' condition to be when books have <u>acceptable wear and tear</u> and signs of use, which would be expected from a book which has been read by previous owner/s and may have some age to it. There may be some hand-writing such as names of previous owner/s of the book and stickers of retailers where books were purchased, on the blank pages (Leaves) at the beginning of the book.

FAIR CONDITION

Heritage Classic Collectables considers 'FAIR' condition to be when books have acceptable wear and tear and some form of damage.

DEFINITIONS

AS NEW CONDITION

Heritage Classic Collectables considers 'as new condition' to be when books are crisp and in the same condition as when they were published. We would expect that this condition would also apply to books previously bought for the first time from a retailer.

ACCEPTABLE WEAR AND TEAR

Heritage Classic Collectables considers 'acceptable wear and tear' to include, but is not limited to:

- slight discolouration: and/or
- age related spots (Foxing); and/or
- scuffing; and/or
- minimal creases or folds; and or
- some tears or minor damage to dust jacket

FAIR CONDITION

Heritage Classic Collectables considers 'fair condition' to be when books have acceptable wear and tear and/or are sufficiently worn and/or have some form of damage.

DAMAGE TO BOOKS IN FAIR CONDITION

Books being sold in 'fair condition' will have some form of damage. Heritage Classic Collectables makes every effort to describe and photograph damage to books, to the best of their ability and as comprehensively as possible. If the purchaser is concerned about the damage, requires clarification or has any questions regarding the type and extent of the damage, they **MUST** email Heritage Classic Collectables using the Contact Us page, **PRIOR** to making their online purchase.
